Transport Manager

Anything Goes is seeking someone to join our dedicated and enthusiastic committee to plan and execute Anything Goes 2019.

Anything Goes is the largest weekend Venturer event in Australia held every year in February and it attracts around 1000 Venturers each year.

We are looking for a hardworking, reliable and passionate person to join our team.

Position Objective

The transport manager will facilitate the transportation of participants to and from the camp site as well as activities. They will also manage and co-ordinate the transport personnel and marshals.

Key Responsibilities

- Organize and co-ordinate buses and bus drivers for the event
- Liaising with the personnel team to organize staff for the event
- Liaising with the activities team to organize bus arrangements.
- Brief marshals about their role as well as coordinate other team members
- Efficiently co-ordinate the movement of participants on and off site
- Put together bus bags which include first aid kits, manifests and emergency information.
- Work with an established Transport Assistant to achieve the best results possible.
- And, any other duties as reasonably requested by the CD or DCD's.

Key Selection Criteria

- Have experience managing a team of people
- Demonstrated time management skills
- Demonstrated ability to work in a team environment
- Demonstrated timetabling skills
- Demonstrated ability to adapt immediately to changes

Time Commitment

This position requires the successful participant to be able to attend committee meetings in the lead-up to the event as well as a wrap up meeting after the event, most of these are held in Warragul, Victoria. There will also be work for about 2-3 (at least) hours a week in the lead up to the event. You will need to be present for the entire event; Friday > Sunday. Applicants should ensure they have the flexibility in their time to be able to accommodate this contribution taking into account their work or study requirements. **This is a volunteer position.**

 - Prior relevant experience;
 - Address the key selection criteria;
 - Include contact details for 2 relevant referees;
 - Why you feel you are the best candidate for the position.

- If successful, applicants will be required to attend an interview either in person or via the internet.
- Applications will be based on merit alone.
- Interviews will assess the applicant on their application.
- All applications are confidential between the Applicant and the Camp Director, as well as any other Team Members who are involved in the application process.
- Timely applications are a must.
